Transition

Geneva Elevator is an organisation funded primarily by contracts with the Government and our parent organisation Geneva Healthcare. We work with disabled students to provide meaningful and rewarding outcomes.

Geneva Elevator offers a Transition from School Programme for students with ORS (Ongoing Reviewable Scheme) and Non-ORS funding. This programme is funded by the Ministry of Social Development. Transition simply means working together with students with a disability, with their families, caregivers and the school to plan for leaving school. We spend time completing a Transition Plan, and provide information and explore all options for work, training or participation in the community.

Work experience and work sampling are valuable for many students to help broaden their understanding of work and its many facets and expectations.

When students leave school, we help provide a seamless move to planned options of their choice which may include paid work, supported by Geneva Elevator, work experience, further training or having a meaningful role in the community.

Geneva Elevator has been working in the Transition area for 15 years and we have developed working relationships with many schools in Auckland.

The move from school can be a difficult and stressful time for many students and their families, and we aim to make this time of change as easy and successful as possible.
